

# Schlitterbahn, Galveston Permission Form Saturday, May 11, 2024

Dear Seabrook Band Parents,

Our students have worked so hard this year! It is time to have a little fun in the sun!! All the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade band students are invited to attend our spring trip to Schlitterbahn Galveston.

The cost of admission is FREE!!!... as long as the kids have passed their 3<sup>rd</sup> 9-weeks report card or have pass the latest progress report.

To safely take students to a water park, CCISD requires 1 adult for every 8 students. Please consider joining us as a chaperone for this event. (Chaperones may either ride the bus or travel in their own vehicle.) We will need at least 4-5 chaperones for the event. Each chaperone will be assigned students for the day. The first 5 to sign-up will receive a free admission.

## The schedule for Saturday, May 11th:

9:00am	Check-In at SIS cafeteria; load buses	
9:30am	Depart for Schlitterbahn, Galveston	
10:15am	Arrive at water park	SCHLITTERBAHN. WATERPARK
11:00am	Water park opens	GALVESTON, TEXAS
1:00pm	Chaperone check in and lunch in our meeting spot	
4:00pm	Check-In at reserved spot; load buses	
4:30pm	Depart for SIS (students planning on leaving with Parents from the park can with a form)	
5:30pm	Arrive at SIS; students should be picked up no later than 6:00pm	

#### What to wear:

- **Girls**: any style of bathing suit with shoulder straps (no strapless), no excessive cut-outs; cover-ups are ok (baggy clothing is not allowed on some slides/ rides)
- **Boys**: swim trunks, board shorts style is ok (no briefs); t-shirts are ok (baggy clothing is not allowed on some slides/rides)
- Shoes: flip flops are not allowed on some slides/rides; water shoes are recommended

### What to bring: (make sure your items are clearly labeled with your name)

- Towel
- **Sunblock:** re-apply to yourself regularly!
- A small bag that will fit into storage lockers: for small personal items; you may also bring food and drink in a small lunch bag that will fit into the storage lockers; the band directors and the other chaperones are not responsible for students' belongings; storage lockers are coin operated.
- **Payment Cards**: Schlitterbahn is a cashless park; students can bring their own payment cards or bring money to load onto a card at a machine in the park (the machines dispense a generic card that can be used anywhere in the park).
- Water-proof pouch/sleeve for phone, payment card: not required, but highly recommended.
- **Student Lunches:** If your kids plan to bring food, please seal and pack in a lunch bag or lunch box with their name labeled on it. The students can leave their lunches at the designated tables where a director or chaperone will keep an eye out. We will bring coolers of waters as well. Again, directors and chaperones are not responsible for lost items.

#### Behavior:

- Students are expected adhere to the CCISD Student Code of Conduct and Band Handbook as this is an off-campus, school-sponsored event.
- Any student who behaves in a manner that detrimental or inappropriate will be removed from the event; a parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up the student and take them home immediately.
- Student will remain with their director until they are picked up.
